- Confirmation of Lumira reactive results (RVH Maternity ONLY)

These tests are a limited resource and should only be requested in the above patients. The sample will NOT BE TESTED unless this information is provided.

DO NOT SEND A SAMPLE FOR PCR IF:

- Patient has tested positive for SARS CoV2 in the last 90 days and has NO new onset of symptoms consistent with COVID-19 or Influenza
